ALL criteria, listed below, must be met in order to qualify for the scholarship. All scholarship applications MUST be received no later than 4pm, April 15, 2018.

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**Please Note :** *All applications must be submitted electronically. There are no paper applications. Computers are available for student use in the Media Center and Student Services before and after school.*

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## Criteria

1. Graduating Senior
2. GPA of 2.5 unweighted or above
3. Have a school counselor verify your unweighted and weighted GPA.
4. Applicant must plan to be enrolled in a community college, accredited college or university; trade or technical school in the 2017-18 year as a full-time student.
5. An essay of no more than 300 words is required (you may attach resume of extracurricular activities, community participation/service; outside employment as well as any outstanding achievements/honors).

**Applicant or applicant's parent/guardian** must be a member in good standing with the Reservoir High School PTSA by March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018

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## Selection Criteria

1. The student's Counselor will confirm the student's GPA and fill out the additional reference form separately and email to the address in the document.
  2. After the students have been identified as valid candidates, Scholarship Committee members will receive each application anonymously (the student's name will be hidden) and review independently.
  3. Upon reviewing the student application form, the Scholarship Committee will identify characteristics and attributes about the student that indicate he/she should receive the scholarship and document them.
  4. The finalists **may be** asked to attend an interview before a committee in the event of a tie.
  5. The award recipients will be announced at the RHS Senior Awards Ceremony in May.
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
